

Information document on the use of cookies

This information document on the use of cookies on the website www.bonettoartlegno.com is given to the user in accordance to the regulation of the Personal Data Protection Supervisory Authority dated 8 May 2014 "Identification of the simplified methods to inform users about the use of cookies and acquire their consent" and pursuant to art. 13 of the EU Regulation 2016/679 on personal data protection (Regulation).

The information document is issued and updated by Bonetto Art-legno srl, which is the website operator and Data controller of the personal data managed through it, based in Via Saviabona 125 - 36010 Monticello Conte Otto (Vicenza, Italy).

In any case, your personal data are processed by subjects specifically appointed by the Data controller and will not be communicated or disclosed to others.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are short text strings that a website may send to your device (pc, notebook, smartphone, tablet) during browsing and that are usually stored on the browser used for the navigation. This website can then read and record the cookies that are on the same device to get information of various kinds. What kind of information? Each type of cookie has a specific function.

HOW MANY TYPES OF COOKIES ARE THERE?

There are two main macro-categories with different characteristics: technical cookies and profiling cookies. Technical cookies are generally necessary for the proper operation of the website and to enable browsing; without them the pages cannot be displayed correctly, and some services cannot be used. For example, a technical cookie is necessary to keep the user connected to a website for the entire browsing time, or to save the language, view, etc. settings.

Technical cookies can be further distinguished into:

navigation cookies, that guarantee the proper browsing and use of the website (by enabling, for example, the purchase of an item or the authentication to access restricted areas);

analytics cookie, that are similar to technical cookies only when they are used directly by the website operator to collect aggregated information on the number of users and on how they visit the website.

functionality cookies, that allow the user to browse the website on the basis of a series of selected criteria (e.g. the language, the items selected for the purchase) in order to improve the service offered.

Profiling cookies are more sophisticated! These cookies profile the user and are used to send advertising messages in line with the preferences expressed by the user while browsing.

WHAT TYPE OF COOKIES DOES THIS WEBSITE USE?

We use technical cookies aimed at guaranteeing the proper operation of our website, such as Google Analytics.

Google Analytics is a web analytics service provided by Google that releases on your device specific cookies that are used for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous information on the website use.

These cookies can be sent by the instrument supplier, but they are used only for purposes connected to the website.
